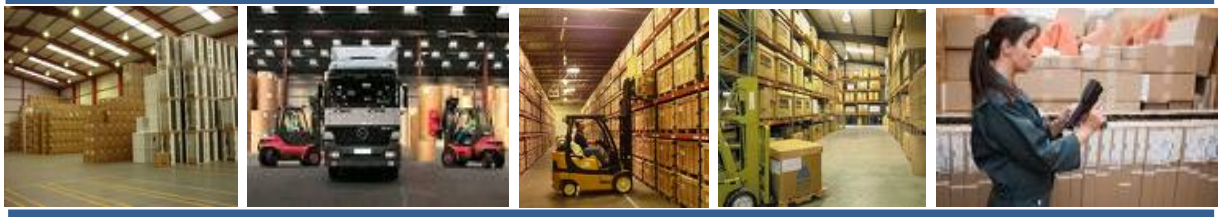


Warehousing and Storage
